ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Control of Traffic (Larne) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1994

Made . . . . . 13th October 1994

Coming into operation . . . . . 24th November 1994

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Larne) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 24th November 1994.

*Prohibition of U-turn*

2. Subject to Article 3 a person shall not cause or permit a vehicle travelling on the road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to make a U-turn at the location specified in column 2.

*Exemptions*

- 3. Article 2 shall not apply to—
  - (a) vehicles being used for fire brigade, ambulance, police or military purposes; or
  - (b) a vehicle, the driver of which is acting upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.

Harbour Highway, Route T9, (eastbound carriageway), Larne	The south-eastern end of the central reservation at its junction with Pound Street

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order prohibits vehicles travelling along Harbour Highway, Route T9, Larne, from making a U-turn at its junction with Pound Street.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be erected on the road in due course.
