**Milk Marketing Scheme (Certification of Revocation) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1995**

Made *20th March 1995*

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 4(5) of the Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Milk Marketing Scheme (Certification of Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

- (a) “the Order” means the Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Order 1993; and
- (b) any reference to a numbered Article shall be construed as a reference to the Article so numbered in the Order.

Certification of Revocation

3. It is hereby certified that—

- (a) property, rights and liabilities of the Board were transferred under Article 14 (statutory transfer on vesting day under approved scheme); and
- (b) in pursuance of Article 4(4), Article 4(1) (which, subject to Article 16 and any provisions of regulations made under Article 17(3)(a), revokes the 1989 Scheme) came into operation in relation to the 1989 Scheme,

on 1st March 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order certifies the revocation of the Milk Marketing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1989 (the "1989 Scheme") on 1st March 1995, subject to the saving below.

Article 4(1) of the Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 ("the 1993 Order") revokes the 1989 Scheme. The date for revocation (1st April 1994 under Article 4(2)) was postponed to 1st April 1995 by the Milk Marketing Scheme (Postponement of Date of Revocation No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 (S.R. 1994 No. 340). However, by virtue of Article 4(4) of the 1993 Order, on the transfer under Article 14 of that Order of property, rights or liabilities of the Milk Marketing Board for Northern Ireland revocation on the transfer date followed as an automatic consequence. The transfer took place on 1st March 1995.

Revocation of the 1989 Scheme is, by virtue of Articles 16 and 17 of the 1993 Order, made subject to a saving in respect of winding-up provisions of the Scheme and other provisions preserved by regulations. Those provisions are set out in Schedule 3 to the Milk Marketing Board (Residuary Functions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995 (S.R. 1995 No. 25).
