## POLICE

**Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1995**

*Made* . . . . . 21st March 1995

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 13th April 1995

*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby makes the following regulations:—

*Citation, operation and effect*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1995 and shall come into operation on 13th April 1995, but shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 3 on and after 1st September 1994.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(c).

*Pay*

3. In regulation 18 of the principal regulations for “£6·11” there shall be substituted “£6·71”.

*Deductions from pay of social security benefits and statutory sick pay*

4. In regulation 20(1)(a) of the principal regulations for the words from “sickness benefit” to “1986” there shall be substituted “short-term or long-term incapacity benefit to which he is entitled under the Social Security (Incapacity for Work) (Northern Ireland) Order 1994(d)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations further amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988.

Regulation 3 increases the rate of pay for members of the force with effect on and after 1st September 1994.

Regulation 4 reflects changes needed on the coming into force of the Social Security (Incapacity for Work) (Northern Ireland) Order 1994.

Retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
