The Department of Agriculture, being a Department designated(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Community, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the said section 2(2) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Apple Orchard Grubbing Up (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 19th January 1995.

Amendment to the Apple Orchard Grubbing Up Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991

2. In the definition of “the Commission Regulation” in regulation 2(1) of the Apple Orchard Grubbing Up Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991(c), the words “and as read with Commission Regulation (EC) No. 3149/94(d)” shall be inserted at the end.

These Regulations amend the Apple Orchard Grubbing Up Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 (“the 1991 Regulations”) by amending the definition of “the Commission Regulation” to take account of Commission Regulation (EC) No. 3149/94. This Commission Regulation derogates from Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 2604/90, by permitting applications for the payment of premium for the grubbing up of apple orchards payable by virtue of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1200/90 (O.J. No. L119, 11.5.90, p. 63, last amended by Council Regulation (EC) No. 1890/94 (O.J. No. L197, 30.7.94, p. 41)), to be made during the month of January 1995.

The amendment to the 1991 Regulations ensures that, from the coming into operation of the amendment, applications for the grubbing up premium made pursuant to the derogation set out in Commission Regulation 3149/94 will be subject to the provisions of the 1991 Regulations.
