ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Parking Places on Roads (Amendment No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1995

Made 24th April 1995

Coming into operation 5th June 1995

WHEREAS it appears to the Department of the Environment to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the parts of the roads specified in the Schedule;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 104(1)(c) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places on Roads (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 5th June 1995.

Amendment

2. The Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1993(b) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 1 to that Order of the items in the Schedule.

316. Bush Park, Antrim, (East Side) — from a point approximately 127 metres north of its junction with Parkhall Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
317. Mill View Place, Ballymena, (North-West Side, in parking area to the rear of No. 14 Clonavon Road) — from a point approximately 37 metres south-west of its junction with North Street, for a distance of approximately 4 metres.
318. Lancasterian Street, Carrickfergus, (South Side) — from a point approximately 32 metres west of its junction with North Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
319. Quoile Park, Downpatrick, (South Side, in front of No. 11) — from a point approximately 170 metres from its junction with Old Belfast Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in a westerly direction.
320. Manor Park, Lisburn, (West Side) — from a point approximately 40 metres south of its junction with Longstone Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
321. Main Street, Moira, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 110 metres north-east of its junction with Backwood Road, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order further amends the Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1993.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places on the parts of the roads specified in the Schedule.
