**The Litter (Designation of Roads) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1995**

Made 23rd January 1995

Coming into operation 27th February 1995

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 2(5) of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Litter (Designation of Roads) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 27th February 1995.

Amendment

2. In the Schedule to the Litter (Designation of Roads) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994(b) after item "A8(m)" add the following item—

"M3	From its junction with the M2 motorway to its junction with Middlepath Street, Belfast".
