The Litter (Non-Relevant Land) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995

Made 5th May 1995

Coming into operation 30th June 1995

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 2(3) of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Litter (Non-Relevant Land) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 30th June 1995.

Relevant Land

2. For the purposes of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994, land below the place to which the tide flows at mean high water springs is not to be treated as relevant Crown land or as relevant land of a district council.

Article 2(3) of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994 gives the Department of the Environment power to designate descriptions of land which are not to be treated as relevant land for the purposes of that Order.

This Order designates land below the place to which the tide flows at mean high water springs as land which is not relevant land of district councils or relevant Crown land.
