## PUBLIC HEALTH

**The Litter (Dog Faeces) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995**

*Made* . . . . . 2nd June 1995

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 7th July 1995

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 2(7) of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

***Citation and commencement***

1. This order may be cited as the Litter (Dog Faeces) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 7th July 1995.

***Application***

2. Articles 7, 8 and 9 of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994 which apply to litter shall apply to dog faeces on land of the following descriptions—

- (a) Relevant Crown land and relevant land of a district council except in both cases woodland, moorland, land used for the grazing of animals and any land specified by the appropriate authority as land where a dog may deposit its excrement;
- (b) Relevant land of a designated educational institution;
- (c) Relevant land within a litter control area of a district council;
- (d) Relevant land of a designated statutory undertaker;
- (e) Any road.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the order.)*

This Order is made under Article 2(7) of the Litter (Northern Ireland) Order 1994 ("the Litter Order") and enables the Department to apply the provisions of the Litter Order which apply to litter to any description of animal droppings in all or any circumstances as may be specified.

The Order provides that Articles 7, 8 and 9 of the Litter Order will apply to dog faeces in the kinds of land specified in Article 2.
