One-Way Traffic (Coleraine) (Amendment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1995

Made . . . . . 10th August 1995

Coming into operation . . . . . 21st September 1995

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Coleraine) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 21st September 1995.

*Amendment*

2. The Schedule to the One-Way Traffic (Coleraine) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the item relating to Beresford Avenue, from its junction with Nursery Avenue to its junction with Mount Street.
