ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Control of Traffic (Belfast) (No. 3) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1995

Made 16th August 1995

Coming into operation 1st October 1995

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Belfast) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1995.

Compulsory left-hand turn

2. Subject to Article 3, every person causing or permitting a vehicle travelling on the roads specified in column 1 of the Schedule in the direction specified in column 2 shall cause or permit that vehicle, on reaching the junctions with the roads specified in column 3, to make a left-hand turn into the roads specified in column 4.

Exemptions

3. Article 2 shall not apply to—

- (a) vehicles being used for fire brigade, ambulance, police or military purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle, the driver of which is acting upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

The effect of this Order is to make it compulsory—

- (a) for vehicles travelling in an easterly direction along Grosvenor Road, Belfast, on reaching its junction with Fisherwick Place and Great Victoria Street, to make a left-hand turn into Fisherwick Place; and
- (b) for vehicles travelling in an easterly direction along Murray Street, Belfast, on reaching its junction with College Square East and Fisherwick Place, to make a left-hand turn into College Square East.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be placed on the roads.
