**Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment No. 2)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1995**

Made 16th August 1995

Coming into operation 1st October 1995

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1995.

Amendment

2. The Schedule to the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended by the substitution for the items relating to Fisherwick Place and York Road of the following items—

Fisherwick Place — both sides	8.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. 4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.	Monday to Friday inclusive

York Road — west side	4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.	Monday to Friday inclusive

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 by prohibiting the waiting by vehicles from Monday to Friday inclusive:

- (1) on both sides of Fisherwick Place, Belfast, between 8.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m.;
- (2) on the east side of York Road, Belfast, between 8.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m.; and
- (3) on the west side of York Road, Belfast, between 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be erected on the roads.
