FIRE SERVICES**The Fire Services (Non-Certificated Factory, Office and Shop Premises) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995**

Made 7th February 1995

Coming into operation 13th March 1995

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 34(1), (3) and (4) and 52(1)(b) of the Fire Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1984(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with such persons or bodies of persons as appear to it requisite, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Non-Certificated Factory, Office and Shop Premises) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 13th March 1995.

Revocation

2. The Fire Services (Non-Certificated Factory, Office and Shop Premises) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke the Fire Services (Non-Certificated Factory, Office and Shop Premises) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 which provided for fire precautions to be taken in certain premises which do not require a fire certificate under the Fire Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1984 ("the 1984 Order"). Article 31 of the 1984 Order (which was substituted by the Fire Services (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1993, Art. 9) now imposes a general statutory duty to provide all premises which are exempt from the requirement for a fire certificate with adequate means of escape in case of fire and means for fighting fire.
