LOCAL GOVERNMENT

The Local Government (Competition in Functional Work) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 7(3) and (4) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1992(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Competition in Functional Work) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1995.
- (2) In these regulations "the Order" means the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1992.

Application of Article 7 of the Order

- 2. Article 7 of the Order (functional work: restrictions) shall apply to any functional work falling within a defined activity specified in column 1 of the Schedule, and which is proposed to be carried out on or after the date specified in relation thereto in column 2 by a council specified in relation thereto in column 3.
- 3. Where a council proposes to carry out functional work which falls within a defined activity specified in the Schedule (whether or not by virtue of Article 4(4) or (6) of the Order) and to which Article 7 of the Order would not otherwise apply, it shall (if the council so decides) be treated as work to which that Article 7 applies.

Local Government EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations describe for the purposes of Article 7(3) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 ("the Order") the nature of the functional work (as defined in Article 3(1) which the councils specified in the Schedule may not carry out on or after the dates specified in the Schedule unless certain conditions (designed to ensure competition) are fulfilled (regulation 2).

If any council wishes to carry out functional work falling within an activity specified in the Schedule but for which competition is not required, it may treat that work as if the competition requirements applied to it (regulation 3).
