ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Control of Traffic (Galgorm, Ballymena) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1995

Made 13th November 1995

Coming into operation 15th December 1995

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Galgorm, Ballymena) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 15th December 1995.

Amendment

2. The Schedule to the One-Way Traffic (Ballymena) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) shall be amended by the addition thereto of the following item—

“

<i>Column 1</i>	<i>Column 2</i>
The service road linking Fenaghy Road and Galgorm Road, Galgorm	South-westerly from Fenaghy Road

”

Prohibition of right-hand turn

3. Subject to Article 4, a person shall not cause or permit a vehicle travelling in a south-westerly direction along the service road linking Fenaghy Road and Galgorm Road, Galgorm, Ballymena, to make a right-hand turn into Galgorm Road.

Exemptions

4. Article 3 shall not apply to—

- (a) vehicles being used for fire brigade, ambulance, police or military purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle, the driver of which is acting upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order—

- (1) provides for the introduction of a one-way traffic system in the service road linking Fenaghy Road and Galgorm Road, Galgorm, Ballymena; and
- (2) prohibits vehicles travelling in a south-westerly direction along the service road linking Fenaghy Road and Galgorm Road, Galgorm, Ballymena, from making a right-hand turn into Galgorm Road.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
