Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1995

Made 7th December 1995 Coming into operation 9th January 1996

The Foyle Fisheries Commission in exercise of its powers under section 13(1) and (2) of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a), and section 13(1) and (2) of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b), with the approval of the Minister for the Marine in the Republic of Ireland(c) and of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland(d), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1995 and shall come into operation on 9th January 1996.
