**Racing Pigeons (Vaccination) (Revocation) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1995**

Made 14th December 1995

Coming into operation 15th January 1996

The Department of Agriculture, being a Department designated(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Community, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the said section 2(2) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Racing Pigeons (Vaccination) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 15th January 1996.

Revocation

2. The Racing Pigeons (Vaccination) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke the Racing Pigeons (Vaccination) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995. Paragraph 12 of the Diseases of Poultry Scheme Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 re-enacts the requirement of those Regulations for the organiser of a show or race to ensure that racing pigeons entered in it have been vaccinated against paramyxovirus 1 infection.
