**Motor Hackney Carriages (Belfast)
(Amendment) By-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1996**

By-Laws amended

2. For the entries relating to Donegall Square North and Donegall Square East in the Schedule to the Bye-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire made by the Council of the County Borough of Belfast on 4th June 1951(1) there shall be substituted—

“DONEGALL SQUARE NORTH	North Side: from a point 12.5m east of the east kerbline of Donegall Place for a distance of 30m in an easterly direction. Carriages shall stand in single line by the kerbline and parallel therewith, facing east	6	At any time
DONEGALL SQUARE EAST	East Side: (a) from a point 7m south of the south kerbline of Chichester Street for a distance of 20m in a southerly direction. Carriages shall stand in single line by the kerbline and parallel therewith, facing south. (b) from a point 7m south of the south kerbline of Chichester	4 4	At any time At any time”
