SCHEDULE 4

Industrial Tribunals (Improvement and Prohibition Notices Appeals) Rules of Procedure 1996 For use in proceedings on an appeal against an improvement notice or prohibition notice

Notice of appeal

- 1. An appeal against an improvement notice or prohibition notice shall be commenced by the appellant sending to the Secretary a notice of appeal which shall be in writing and shall set out—
 - (a) the name and address of the appellant and, if different, an address within the United Kingdom to which he requires notices and documents relating to the appeal to be sent;
 - (b) the date of the improvement notice or prohibition notice appealed against and the address of the premises or place concerned;
 - (c) the name and address of the respondent;
 - (d) particulars of the requirements or directions appealed against; and
 - (e) the grounds of the appeal.
