**Plant Health (Wood and Bark) (Amendment)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 1996**

**Amendment of the Plant Health (Wood and Bark) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993**

3. In Article 2(1) (Interpretation)—
- (a) for the definition of “dunnage” there shall be substituted the following definition—  
    ““dunnage” means wood of any kind used to wedge or support parts of a cargo and includes packing material, spacers and pallets;”
  - (b) after the definition of “inspector” there shall be inserted the following definitions—  
    ““Ireland” and “United Kingdom” have the same respective meanings as in Directive [77/93/EEC](#).”
  - (c) in the definition of “plant passport” for the word “information” there shall be substituted “information”.
