The Social Security (Back to Work Bonus) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996

Waiting period

6.—(1) A person shall not be entitled to a bonus unless he has served or is treated as having served a waiting period.

(2) A waiting period is the period comprising the first 91 days in a period of entitlement to a qualifying benefit in which the claim for the bonus is made or which precedes a claim made in accordance with regulation 23(1)(b) (claiming a bonus).
