**POLICE**

**Police (Amendment) (1995 Order) (Commencement  
No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1996**

*Made* - - - - *23rd July 1996*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 1(2) and 1(3) of the Police (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1995(1), (“the 1995 Order”) I hereby make the following Order:—

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Police (Amendment) (1995 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1996.

**Appointed day**

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of Part II of the 1995 Order shall be 29th July 1996.

**Transitional provisions**

3.—(1) Article 3 of the 1995 Order shall apply to persons taken to a police station from a custodial establishment in pursuance of a direction under section 16 of the Prison Act (Northern Ireland) 1953(2), notwithstanding that the direction was made before the appointed day.

(2) Article 4 of the 1995 Order shall apply notwithstanding that the person was unlawfully at large before the appointed day.
