

SCHEDULE 5

Regulation 27

**Evidence of Identity of Theory Test Candidates**

- 1. The documents referred to in regulation 27(2) and (4) are—
  - (a) a passport;
  - (b) a cheque guarantee card or credit card bearing a photograph and signature of the person;
  - (c) an employer’s identity card bearing a photograph and signature of the person;
  - (d) a trade union card bearing a photograph and signature of the person;
  - (e) a photograph of the person which has been endorsed with a certificate in the prescribed form signed by an acceptable person.

2. In this Schedule—

“acceptable person” means a Member of Parliament, district council councillor, Justice of the Peace, a minister of religion, barrister, solicitor, teacher, medical practitioner, bank official, established civil servant or police officer.

“the prescribed form”, in relation to a certificate, means the following—

“I, [Name of acceptable person], certify that this is a true likeness of [Name of candidate], who has been known to me for ... years in my capacity as [Specify capacity]
