Regulation 27

Evidence of Identity of Theory Test Candidates

- 1. The documents referred to in regulation 27(2) and (4) are-
- (a) a passport;
- (b) a cheque guarantee card or credit card bearing a photograph and signature of the person;
- (c) an employer's identity card hearing a photograph and signature of the person;
- (d) a trade union card bearing a photograph and signature of the person:
- (e) a photograph of the person which has been endorsed with a certificate in the prescribed form signed by an acceptable person.
- 2. In this Schedule-

"acceptable person" means a Member of Parliament, district council councillor, Justice of the Peace, a minister of religion, barrister, solicitor, teacher, medical practitioner, bank official, established civil servant or police officer.

"the prescribed form", in relation to a certificate, means the following-
