# Public Order (Prescribed Form) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997

*Made - - - - 30th April 1997* 

To be laid before Parliament

Coming into operation 9th May 1997

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of Article 3(2) of the Public Order (Northern Ireland) Order 1987(1) hereby makes the following regulations:—

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Public Order (Prescribed Form) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997 and shall come into operation on 9th May 1997.

### **Notice of Public Processions**

**2.** Advance notice of a public procession shall be given in the Form in the Schedule.
