# Packaging, Labelling and Carriage of Radioactive Material by Rail Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998

#### Part V

#### General Carriage and Operating Requirements

#### Suitability of freight containers, tank containers, tank wagons and wagons

**18.**—(1) A person shall not cause or permit to be carried any radioactive material in a freight container, tank container, tank wagon or wagon unless the freight container, tank container, tank wagon or wagon concerned—

- (a) is suitable for the purpose, having regard to—
  - (i) the nature and circumstances of the journey to be undertaken, and
  - (ii) the hazardous properties and quantity of the radioactive material and any other goods to be carried with it; and
- (b) has been adequately maintained.

(2) A train operator shall not cause or permit to be carried any radioactive material in a freight container, tank container, tank wagon or wagon unless he has taken all reasonable steps to ensure that paragraph (1) has been complied with.
