The Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1998

Made---18th November 1998Coming into operation1st December 1998

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(1), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1998 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1998.

Fees to be taken in the Enforcement of Judgments Office

2. In Part I of the Schedule to the Judgment Enforcement Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1996(**2**) for the amount of–

- (i) £15.00, payable in respect of Fee No. 1, there shall be substituted the amount of £20.00;
- (ii) £120.00, payable in respect of Fee No. 3, there shall be substituted the amount of £125.00;
- (iii) £500.00, payable in respect of Fee No. 4, there shall be substituted the amount of £515.00; and
- (iv) £5.00, payable in respect of Fee No. 9, there shall be substituted the amount of £6.00.
