**Amendment of the Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1998**

2. Regulation 8 of the Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998<sup>(1)</sup> shall be amended as follows—

- (a) in paragraph (1) for the words “paragraph (2)” there shall be substituted the words “paragraphs (2) and (3)”; and
- (b) after paragraph (2) there shall be added the following paragraph—

“(3) Where the principal of a school—

- (a) receives information relating to a pupil in the final year of the third key stage after 30th June in any school year; and
- (b) that information is specified in paragraph 2(1)(a) of Schedule 1,

he shall send that information together with the information relating to the same pupil specified in paragraph 2(1)(b) and (c) of that Schedule to the parent of that pupil (whether by post or otherwise) not later than 30th September in the school year following the school year to which the information relates.”.
