**The Education (1998 Order) (Commencement  
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999**

*Made* - - - - *22nd July 1999*

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 1(3) and 90(3) of the Education (Northern Ireland) Order 1998<sup>(1)</sup> and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and interpretation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (1998 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999.

**Appointed day**

2. Article 13 of the Education (Northern Ireland) Order 1998 shall come into operation on 1st September 1999.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order brings into operation on 1st September 1999 Article 13 of the Education (Northern Ireland) Order 1998. That Article requires the scheme of management for each grant-aided school to provide that it is the duty of the Board of Governors of the school to prepare, and from time to time revise, a school development plan. It also enables the Department to make regulations

- (a) prescribing the matters to be dealt with by the plan;
- (b) prescribing the period for which the plan is to have effect;
- (c) prescribing the manner in which the plan is to be published; and
- (d) providing for the revision of the plan.
