**Foyle Area (Control of Fishing) Regulations 1999**

**Suspension of netting and angling on the River Roe**

**6.—(1)** Any period of suspension declared in relation to any waters under regulations 3, 4 or 5 shall—

- (a) fall outside the weekly close time (if any) for those waters; and
- (b) not take effect less than 6 hours after the publication of the certificate containing the declaration.

(2) Where the Commission has, in any annual season, declared a period of suspension in relation to any waters—

- (a) for a period of 24 hours under regulation 4(2), any further period of suspension under paragraphs 3(2) and 4(2) in the same season in relation to those waters shall not exceed 24 hours;
- (b) for a period of 48 hours under regulation 3(2), no further declaration of a period of suspension under paragraphs 3(2) and 4(2) shall be made in the same season in relation to those waters.
