The Office of the First Minister and deputy First Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of the Equality (Disability, etc.) (Northern Ireland) Order 2000⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Equality (Disability, etc.) (2000 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 2000.

(2) In this Order—

“the 1995 Act” means the Disability Discrimination Act 1995⁽²⁾; and

“the 2000 Order” means the Equality (Disability, etc.) (Northern Ireland) Order 2000.
