SALARIES

Salaries (Assembly Ombudsman and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 2000

Made 5th October 2000 Coming into operation . 10th November 2000

The Office of the First Minister and deputy First Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 5(1) and (2) of the Ombudsman (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(a) and Article 4(1) and (2) of the Commissioner for Complaints (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(b) and now vested in it(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Salaries (Assembly Ombudsman and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 2000 and shall come into operation on 10th November 2000.

Revocation

2. The Salaries (Assembly Ombudsman and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999(d) is hereby revoked.

Increase in Salaries

3. The annual salaries payable to the Assembly Ombudsman and the Commissioner for Complaints shall be increased from £84,483 to £92,000 from 1st September 2000.
