## HOUSING; RATES; SOCIAL SECURITY

The Social Security (Miscellaneous Amendments No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001

Made - - - 26th March 2001

Coming into operation in accordance with regulation I

The Department for Social Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 122(1) (a) and (d), 123(1)(e), 131(1), 132(3) and (4)(a) and (b), 134(1)(a) and 171(1), (3) and (4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992(1) and now vested in it(2), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the consent of the Department of Finance and Personnel(3) in so far as regulation 2 is concerned, and after agreement by the Social Security Advisory Committee that proposals in respect of that regulation should not be referred to it(4), hereby makes the following Regulations:
