The Social Fund (Cold Weather Payments) (General) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002

Made - - - - 8th October 2002

Coming into operation 1st November 2002

The Department for Social Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 134(2) and 171(1), (3) and (4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992(1), and now vested in it(2), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Fund (Cold Weather Payments) (General) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002 and shall come into operation on 1st November 2002.
- (2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(3) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.

Amendment of the Schedule to the Social Fund (Cold Weather Payments) (General) Regulations

2. In the Schedule to the Social Fund (Cold Weather Payments) (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988(**4**) (National Climatological Message Station) for the entry "LISBURN" where it appears in Column (1), there shall be substituted "KATESBRIDGE".
