The Department for Social Development, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 35A(4)(a), 159(3), 160(9)(c), 167(5), 167ZP(2) and (3) and 171(1) to (4) of, and paragraph 2 of Schedule 13 to, the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992⁽¹⁾, and now vested in it⁽²⁾, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, by this statutory rule, which contains only regulations made by virtue of, or consequential upon, Articles 3 to 6 of the Employment (Northern Ireland) Order 2002⁽³⁾, hereby makes the following Regulations:
