**2004 No. 163**

**The Social Security (Income-Related Benefits Self-Employment Route Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004**

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Income-Related Benefits Self-Employment Route Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004 and shall come into operation on 4th May 2004.

(2) In these Regulations –

“the Income Support Regulations” means the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987<sup>(1)</sup>;

“the Jobseeker’s Allowance Regulations” means the Jobseeker’s Allowance Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996<sup>(2)</sup>.

(3) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954<sup>(3)</sup> shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.
