**Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland (General)  
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004**

**Amendment of the principal Regulations**

2. In regulation 9 of the principal Regulations (Qualifications for registration), after paragraph (2), add the following paragraph –

“(3) Where a person –

- (a) has been registered as a pharmaceutical chemist for a period of two years or more;
- (b) gives to the registrar a certificate stating that he has satisfactorily completed a training programme accredited by the Society for the annotation “SP” (Supplementary Prescriber) to be recorded against his name; and
- (c) pays a fee of £25 to the Society,

he shall be entitled to have that annotation recorded against his name by the registrar in that register.”.
