**HOUSING**

**The Service of Certain Documents (Prescribed Body) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004**

*Made - - - - 27th September 2004*

*Coming into operation 1st November 2004*

The Department for Social Development(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 104(2) of the Housing (Northern Ireland) Order 1992(2), and now exercisable by it(3), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Service of Certain Documents (Prescribed Body) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004 and shall come into operation on 1st November 2004.

**Prescribed Body**

2. The Department hereby prescribes a registered housing association as a prescribed body for the purposes of Article 104 of the Housing (Northern Ireland) Order 1992.
