PART 2

HAZARDOUS AND NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE

Meaning of hazardous waste

- 6. Subject to regulation 10, a waste is a hazardous waste if it is for the time being—
 - (a) featured in the List of Wastes(1) as a hazardous waste; or
 - (b) any other waste which (being a waste considered(2) to display one or more of the properties listed in Annex III) is a hazardous waste pursuant to regulation 8; and
 - (c) a specific waste which, though of a type indicated in the List of Wastes as non-hazardous, is determined pursuant to regulation 9 to be a hazardous waste(3),

and the term "hazardous" and cognate expressions shall be construed accordingly.

⁽¹⁾ Wastes listed as hazardous in the List of Wastes are considered hazardous pursuant to the first indent of Article 1.4 of the Hazardous Waste Directive and the European Waste Catalogue

⁽²⁾ A waste which a member state considers displays any of the properties in Annex III is a hazardous waste pursuant to the second indent of Article 1.4 of the Hazardous Waste Directive

⁽³⁾ A specific waste which though not indicated in the List of Wastes as hazardous may br considered pursuant to Article 3 of the List of Wastes Decision to be hazardous if it displays one or more of the properties in Annex III
