## SCHEDULE 1

### **Amendments of the Pension Schemes Act relating to contracted-out occupational and appropriate personal pension schemes, extending those provisions to surviving civil partners**

15. In section 43(1) (further provisions concerning entitlement to guaranteed minimum pensions for the purposes of section 42)—

- (a) in subsection (1) after “widower” there shall be inserted “or surviving civil partner”;
- (b) in subsection (3)—
  - (i) for “widow or widower”, in each place where it occurs, there shall be substituted “widow, widower or surviving civil partner”, and
  - (ii) for “widow’s or widower’s” there shall be substituted “widow’s, widower’s or surviving civil partner’s”.
