## SCHEDULE 3

## Amendment of legislation relating to social security

## Social Security (Credits) Regulations

4.—(1) The Social Security (Credits) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(1) shall be amended in accordance with sub-paragraphs (2) to (4).

(2) In regulation 7A(1)(2) (credits for carer's allowance), for "widow or widower" there shall be substituted "widow, widower or surviving civil partner".

- (3) In regulation 7C(3) (credits for working tax credit)—
  - (a) in paragraphs (2)(a) and (3), for "a married or unmarried couple" there shall be substituted "a couple";
  - (b) in paragraph (6), for ""married couple" and "unmarried couple" have" there shall be substituted ""couple" has"(4).

(4) In regulation 8C(2)(5) (credits on termination of bereavement benefits), after "remarriage" there shall be inserted ", forming a civil partnership,".
