Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensions (2005 Order) (Codes of Practice) (Early Leavers, Late Payment of Contributions and Trustee Knowledge and Understanding) (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006.

- (a) the Pensions Regulator Code of practice No. 4: Early leavers – reasonable periods;
- (b) the Pensions Regulator Code of practice No. 5: Reporting late payment of contributions to occupational money purchase schemes;
- (c) the Pensions Regulator Code of practice No. 6: Reporting late payment of contributions to personal pensions, and
- (d) the Pensions Regulator Code of practice No. 7: Trustee knowledge and understanding (TKU),
