The Community Benefit Societies (Restriction on Use of Assets) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006

PART I

CITATION, COMMENCEMENT AND INTERPRETATION

**Interpretation**

2.—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954<sup>(1)</sup> applies to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.

(2) In these Regulations—

“the 2006 Order” means the Industrial and Provident Societies (Northern Ireland) Order 2006;

“the 1969 Act” means the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969<sup>(2)</sup>;

“the Registrar” means the Registrar of Industrial and Provident Societies;

“charity” has the meaning given by section 35 of the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 1964<sup>(3)</sup>;

“committee” and “officer” have the meaning given by section 101 of the 1969 Act;

“community benefit society” has the meaning given by Article 9(8) of the 2006 Order;

“prescribed community benefit society” means a community benefit society of the kinds prescribed by regulation 5;

“registered housing association” means a housing association registered in the register maintained by the Department of the Environment under Article 14 of the Housing (Northern Ireland) Order 1992<sup>(4)</sup>;

“a restriction on use” means a rule included in the rules of a prescribed community benefit society which is in the terms set out in Schedule 1.
