CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH A LICENCE IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE 2004 ACT

13. The supply by a person (A) to a farmer of a single worker to undertake agricultural work in which that worker is specialised where—

- (a) the farmer requires the worker to hold a specific qualification at or above National Vocational Qualification Level 2 (as recognised under section 24(4) of the Education Act 1997, or Scottish National Vocational Level 2 (as recognised under part 1 clause 3 of the Education (Scotland) Act 1996, or an equivalent qualification, which is relevant and necessary to ensure the worker can effectively discharge the responsibilities he will be required to undertake; and
- (b) the farmer employs the worker following his supply by A; and
- (c) on the day the supply is made, no other worker is supplied to the farmer by A.
