The Smoke-Free (Signs) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007

Citation, commencement, and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Smoke-Free (Signs) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007 and shall come into operation on 30th April 2007.
 - (2) In these Regulations—
 - "the Order" means the Smoking (Northern Ireland) Order 2006;
 - "entrance" means an entrance for use by persons;
 - "no-smoking symbol" means a symbol which consists of a graphic representation of a single burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle of at least 75 millimetres in diameter with a red bar across it;
 - "smoke-free premises" means all public places and workplaces other than those that are exempt by virtue of regulations made under Article 4 of the Order; and
 - "smoke-free vehicle" means a vehicle which is smoke-free by virtue of Regulations made under Article 6 of the Order.
