# **ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007

Made - - - - Coming into operation

29th June 2007 3rd September 2007

The Department of the Environment makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 5(3), (4) and (5), 19C(1) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(1).

In accordance with Article 19C(3) of that Order, the Department of Finance and Personnel(2) approves regulation 2(3).

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007 and shall come into operation on 3rd September 2007.

### Amendment of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996

**2.**—(1) The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996(**3**) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In regulation 29 (nature of tests other than extended tests), for paragraph (6A)(4) substitute—

"(6A) The test of driving theory shall—

- (a) be conducted as an approved form of examination consisting of—
  - (i) 50 questions in the case of a motor vehicle included in category A, B or P; and
  - (ii) 60 questions in the case of a motor vehicle included in category C or D,

the questions being in either a multiple choice or multiple response form and testing a candidate on the specified matters in accordance with Schedule 6; and

- (b) have a duration time—
  - (i) in the case of a motor vehicle included in category A, B or P, 57 minutes, or in the circumstances specified in paragraph (7), 114 minutes; and
  - (ii) in the case of a motor vehicle included in category C or D, 70 minutes, or in the circumstances specified in paragraph (7), 140 minutes.".

(3) In Schedule 4A(5) (fees for theory tests), in column (2), for "£20.50", in each place where it occurs, substitute "£28.50".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations further amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996 so as to increase from 35 to 50 the number of theory test questions in respect of category A (motor bicycles), category B (motor cars) and category P (mopeds). The duration of the theory test in respect of those categories has been increased from 40 minutes to 57 minutes. Where the candidate because of reading difficulties requires the help of a suitably qualified person the time allowed has been increased from 80 minutes to 114 minutes.

The situation remains unchanged in relation to the theory test in respect of categories C (lorries) and D (buses).

The fees for theory tests in respect of categories A, B and P have been increased from £20.50 to £28.50. The fees in respect of categories C and D remain unchanged.
