**The Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007**

**Export of infant formula to third countries**

**26.**—(1) A person shall not export to a third country any infant formula which contravenes or fails to comply with—

- (a) regulation 5, 6, 8, 10, 11 12, 14(1), (2) or (3), 17 or 19;
- (b) the Codex Standard for Infant Formula established by the Codex Alimentarius<sup>(1)</sup>; or
- (c) The Food (Lot Marking) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996<sup>(2)</sup>.

(2) A person shall not export to a third country a product represented as suitable for satisfying by itself the nutritional requirements of normal healthy infants during the first four to six months of life unless that product is infant formula.
