The Rates (Recreational Hereditaments) Order (Northern Ireland) 2007

Made - - - - - *12th February 2007*

Coming into operation - *1st April 2007*

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 7(3) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland Act 2000

The Department of Finance and Personnel, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 31(2) and (6)(a) of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(b), makes the following Order.

In accordance with Article 31(6) of that Order it has consulted the Sports Council for Northern Ireland and the Northern Ireland Local Government Association (being an Association which appears to the Department to be representative of district councils):

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates (Recreational Hereditaments) Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2007.

Specification of kinds of recreation

2. Recreations of the kinds set out in the Schedule (being recreations which in the opinion of the Department of Finance and Personnel demand an appreciable degree of physical effort) are specified for the purposes of Article 31 of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977.

Revocation

- 3.—(1) The Rates (Recreational Hereditaments) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976(c) is revoked.
(2) The Rates (Recreational Hereditaments) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979(d) is revoked.
