The Health and Social Services Trusts (Membership and Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007

Made--12th February 2007Coming into operation5th March 2007

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 10(6) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1991(2), makes the following Regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health and Social Services Trust (Membership and Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007 and shall come into operation on 5th March 2007.

(2) In these Regulations—

"the principal Regulations" means the Health and Social Services Trusts (Membership and Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994(**3**).

Amendment of regulation 2 of the principal Regulations

2. In regulation 2 (*Maximum number of Directors*) of the principal Regulations for the word "eleven" substitute the word "thirteen".
