## Hereditaments which are not in the social sector

1. A hereditament which is shown, or would fall to be shown, in the NAV list other than a hereditament which is also shown, or would also fall to be shown, in the capital value list.

  - (a) is an employee of the Northern Ireland Housing Executive or of a registered housing association listed in Schedule 1;
  - (b) resides in the hereditament in connection with his employment by that body; and
  - (c) has no liability for rates in respect of the hereditament during his period of residence there.
- (2) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (1), a hereditament—
  - (a) which is not in use; and
- (b) which the Department considers will, when next in use, fall within that sub-paragraph, shall be deemed to be in use and to fall within that sub-paragraph.

- 4.—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), a hereditament which is distinguished in the capital value list as exempt to any extent from rates.
