the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981;

the Legal Advice and Assistance Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981;

the Adoption Allowance Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996;

the National Minimum Wage Regulations 1999;

the Education (Student Loans) (Repayment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000;

the Asylum Support Regulations 2000;

the Tax Credits (Income Thresholds and Determination of Rates) Regulations 2002;

the Child Benefit (General) Regulations 2006;

the Healthy Start Scheme and Day Care Food Scheme Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006; and

the Gender Recognition (Application Fees) Order 2006.
